Points of information regarding our school

- School begins at 9.20 am. Children can be dropped off from 9.10 am onwards. It finishes at 2.00 pm for Junior and Senior Infants and 3 pm for all other classes. However, for the first two weeks in September all Junior Infants will go home at 12.30 pm.
- 2. Infants for 2021-2022 may come to school on **Friday**, **11**th **June up to 12.30 pm** to familiarise themselves with the school, etc. No uniform is required for this day.
- 3. Pupils are encouraged to bring healthy lunches. Cans of drink, chewing gum or crisps of any kind are not allowed. Monday is 'No Sweet Day' in our school.
