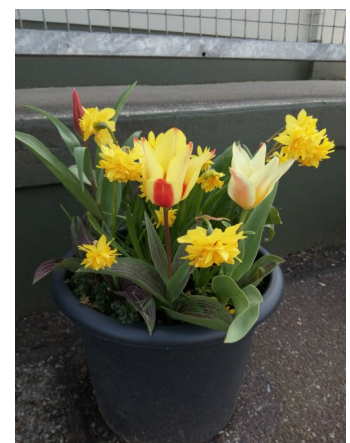
On 16th March we had a 'Green Day' and collected €96. This money is going to Cork Penny Dinners.
