Points of information regarding our school

- School begins at 9.20 am. Children can be dropped off from 9.10 am onwards. It finishes at 2.00 pm for Junior and Senior Infants and 3 pm for all other classes. However, for the first two weeks in September all Junior Infants will go home at 12.30 pm.
- 2. Tirelton NS now operates a Breakfast Club commencing from 7 am every morning and an After School Service from 2 pm to 6 pm. This service is run by an independent contractor 'Curious Minds'
- **3.** Infants for 2025-2026 may come to school on **Friday**, **13**th **June up to 12.30 pm** to familiarise themselves with the school, etc. No uniform is required for this day.
